

Summary of COVID-19 Emergency Policy

Access prerequisites.

No one (students, staff, etc.) can enter school if:

- body temperature equal to or greater than 37.5 C;
- in the presence of flu-like symptoms, coming from risky areas or contact with people positive for the virus in the previous 14 days.

Families are committed to:

To detain your child at home in the presence of a fever (equal to or above 37.5 degrees) or other flu-like symptoms and to inform the paediatrician and school of the onset of symptoms in a timely manner, by contacting the reference school by phone or by email with the address assigned by the school to each pupil, the reference teacher of the class/section;

It is to be aware and accept that, in the event of a fever (temperature equal to or above 37.5 degrees) or other flu-like symptoms, the school provides for the isolation of the student and immediately informs the family members. The physician/paediatrician of free choice will evaluate the case and will, if necessary, contact the Department of Public Health (DPH) for the expected investigations;

Access to school premises by parents and strangers:

-Access to school premises can only be done by appointment or in emergencies.

Using the mask.

Primary and secondary school pupils wear masks at the entrance to the school and during any movement within the school building.

Anyone who enters the school premises must wear a surgical mask for the entire stay.

Pupils in kindergarten follow the different rules set out in the CTS.

Physical distance

In addition to the continuous use of the mask, in all school premises it is mandatory to maintain the physical distance between people of at least 1 linear meter.

Pupils in kindergarten follow the different rules set out in the CTS.

Hand hygiene.

The school provides students and staff in every classroom, and at several points in the school building, dispensers with sanitizing hand hygiene products at the time of entry.

Pupils and staff should take care of the frequent cleaning and sanitation of the hands.

Cleaning the premises.

Prior to the resumption of classes, the Institute carried out a thorough cleaning of all school premises for teaching and not.

Students enter and exit.

Students enter and exit the specific entrances assigned for each class/section.

Recreation.

During recreation, primary and secondary school pupils can have a home-made snack.

Responsibility.

Failure to comply with this regulation can be a source of important criminal civil, administrative and disciplinary liabilities.
